The college has an active student life program, which includes drama productions, intramural sports, retreats, choral music groups, backpacking, canoeing, and ski outings.

The intercollegiate sports program at CRC includes institutional participation in men's basketball, baseball, and golf; and women's basketball, volleyball, and softball. Men's & women's cross country began in 2017.

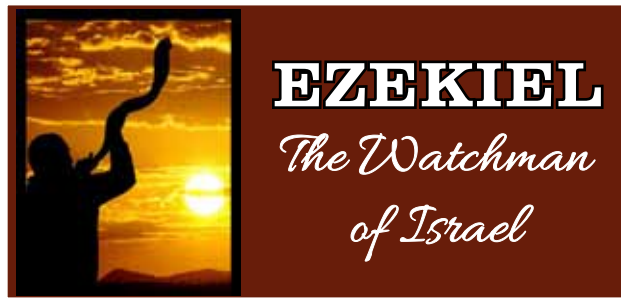
